

PRAYING GOD'S PROMISES

John 3:16-18a

16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. **17** For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. **18** Whoever believes in him is not condemned. . . (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I thank you that you didn't come to condemn me for my many sins. Instead, You willingly gave your life to offer me salvation. I do believe with all my heart and accept your generous offer. I am assured that I will never suffer condemnation.

John 4:13-14

13 Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, **14** but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I rejoice because the Holy Spirit came to live in me when I accepted your precious gift of salvation. You promise to be there for me whenever I thirst. Thank you for giving your life for me. I believe you will provide everything I need from the source of life living within me.

John 4:25-26

25 The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us." **26** Then Jesus declared, "I, who speak to you, am he." (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for revealing yourself to me just like you did to the woman at the well. Neither of us deserves your mercy and grace, but you chose to make yourself known because of your love. Help me to leave what I possess at Your feet so that I can bring others to you just like this adulterous woman did. (see v. 28-30)

John 5:24

24 I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I have heard your word and have believed with all my heart that the Father sent you into the world to pay the price for my sins. I believe that I will never be condemned because I now have eternal life, having crossed over from death to life.

PRAYING GOD'S PROMISES

John 5:28-29

28 Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice **29** and come out—those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned. (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I know that the only **good** thing I have done is to receive you into my heart. That one act, alone, assures me that I will rise to live, not to be condemned. Thank you for providing such a marvelous plan of salvation.

John 6:35

35 Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty." (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you that you will always supply all my needs. Whenever I hunger or thirst, I promise to depend on you. Help me to hunger and thirst daily for Your righteousness.

John 6:37

37 All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for the security that you give. I have come to you for salvation. I believe you will hold me close and never push me away.

John 6:40

40 For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. (NIV)

Prayer: Heavenly Father, You have provided a way out for any sinner who believes. I look to Jesus and believe in Him with all my heart. I accept your promise to raise me up at the last day.

John 6:63

63 The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you—they are spirit and they are life. (NIV)

Prayer: Precious Holy Spirit, I thank you for providing real life to me. You teach me God's Word and God's will daily as I am able to understand. Thank you that my own fleshly, sin nature has been replaced by your presence.

PRAYING GOD'S PROMISES

John 7:17

17 If anyone chooses to do God's will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own. (NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I **do** choose to do your will. Teach me your Word and help me to discern how to apply it to this lost world I live in. I believe your teachings all come from God, because you are God in the flesh.

John 7:37-39

37 On the last and greatest day of the feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "If anyone is thirsty let him come to me and drink. 38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him." 39 By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

(NIV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I have come to you for salvation and you have placed your Spirit within me. I believe in you with all my heart. Fulfill your Word by filling me with your Spirit so that I will always experience this Living Water at work within me.
