

PRAYING GOD'S PROMISES (# 3)

John 13:10

10 Jesus answered, "A person who has had a bath needs only to wash his feet; his whole body is clean. And you are clean, though not every one of you." (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, this is one of the most important truths You taught us. I believe that Your **red** blood covers my **black** sins and makes me **whiter than snow!** As a result of being washed in the blood, I have been baptized in the water picturing my acceptance of Your death and resurrection. I now willingly come before you whenever my feet get dirty from my daily walk in this sinful world. Thank You for paying a debt You did not owe, because I owed a debt I could not pay.

John 14:1-6

14 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. **2** In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. **3** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. **4** And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. **5** Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way? **6** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. (KJV)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for all the promises contained in this marvelous passage. I have a mansion in glory because You died for my many sins. You will come back for me on the day that you have predetermined and take me to live in my new heavenly home. You are the only One who provides these benefits for me. I worship You because you have taken all the fear out of living. I trust You forever with my life and my soul.

John 14:12-14

12 I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. **13** And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. **14** You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it. (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I confess that these promises are too big for me to grasp. I suppose you mean that there are so many Christians available to do Your work that the scope of our combined ministries exceeds what You were able to do in Your human body. Thank you for offering all the riches of heaven **in Your Name**. Help me to ask for nothing more than You would have asked for while you dwelt on earth.

John 14:15-17

15 "If you love me, you will obey what I command. **16** And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever— **17** the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you." (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Father, thank You for sending the Holy Spirit to live in me. Thank You for allowing Jesus to die for my sins so that the Counselor can abide in me forever. Thank You for using Your Spirit to teach me truth from Your Word. I willingly choose to obey Your commands so that the Spirit can deepen my understanding.

John 14:19

19 Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank You that I can still see you in this world that rejects you! Thank You that Eternal Life is granted to me because You came back from the tomb to live forevermore. I know that persecutions are coming to America to those who truly believe in You and Your Word. Keep me strong by Your power and safe in Your arms!

John 14:21

21 “Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him.” (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Thank you, Lord Jesus, that all the riches of heaven are available to those who obey Your Word. The entire Trinity is involved in loving me. Sometimes, I don’t feel lovable, but You chose to die for me in my sinful state, and though I am undeserving of that great love, You give it freely. I claim this promise and stand on it—especially when I am feeling unlovely. Thank you for promising to show Yourself to me.

John 14:23

23 Jesus replied, “If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.” (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank You that the entire Trinity lives in me in the form of the Holy Spirit. I do love you with all my heart. Help me to live a life of obedience to You and Your Word.

John 14:26-27

26 But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. **27** Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Heavenly Father, I praise You for sending the Holy Spirit to those who call on the Name of Jesus Christ. I know that His **Name** incorporates everything Christ is and everything He does. The Spirit will teach me all things and remind me of the things I have already learned. This assures me of an inner **peace** that the world cannot give or take away! I praise You because I do not need to fear anything or anyone in this world that is under the control of Satan.

John 15:5

5 “I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.” (NIV 1984)

Prayer: Lord Jesus, Thank You that You do all the hard work in the fruit bearing process. I am only a branch drawing strength from You, the Vine. You feed me and hold me up so that the winds of life will not destroy me. Thank You for making my role so clear: Through You, I can do all things; without You, I can do nothing. Please teach me to give You glory for all the fruit that comes from my ministry.
